Views on Methods of Social Change: GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, June 30, 2009

According to a Gilani Research Foundation survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, public attitude is divided on how best to change and improve society. A third of Pakistanis subscribe to revolutionary views, another third support gradual reform and the remaining third want the status quo to remain. Interestingly, men showed a proportionately higher preference for revolutionary change while women claimed to equally support both revolution and gradual reformation for bringing change in society.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the country were read out three basic attitudes towards changing and improving society and asked which in their opinion is better. A third of the respondents, 37%, agree that **“Our society needs a complete change through revolution”** and another third, 35%, agree that **“Society needs to be changed gradually through reforms”**. The remaining 20% of the respondents believe that **“Instead of talking about revolution and change, the existing society should be improved”** and 9% were unsure or did not respond.

Amongst men, majority (40%) believes that a revolution is required; amongst women equal percentage (33%) support both revolution and gradual change. The results also indicate that a slightly higher percentage of respondents in the 50+ yrs age group think society can best be changed through gradual reform.

The study was released by Gilani foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The latest survey was carried out among a sample of 2759 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 2009. Error margin is estimated to be approximately \pm 2-3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
